

Section 2. The Board further finds that alternative alignments proposed by the LCRA for the Transmission Line Project are located in less densely populated areas that are further from residential areas and that constructing the Transmission Line Project along such alternative alignments would better serve the public interest.

Section 3. The Secretary of the Board is directed to file a copy of this Resolution in the principal office of the District and with the LCRA and the PUC.


Exhibit A
